- vii. Discuss the following statement: “Doing God’s work, and obeying, and finding the power to live for God... is less about straining and striving... and more about moving into the current of the Spirit.”
- viii. What does it mean to be consciously dependant on the Spirit... as individuals? ...as a church? ...and what risks are involved?
